

Force Main Improvements



PROJECT DETAILS

In order to improve long-term wastewater service reliability, Orange County Utilities will remove and replace existing force main pipes in nine locations:

- Legacy Oaks Drive
- Bachman Road
- Voltaire Drive
- South Texas Avenue
- Whisper Lakes Boulevard
- Boice Street and Hawkes Avenue
- Plantation Pointe Drive
- Diamond Cove Circle
- Landstar Boulevard

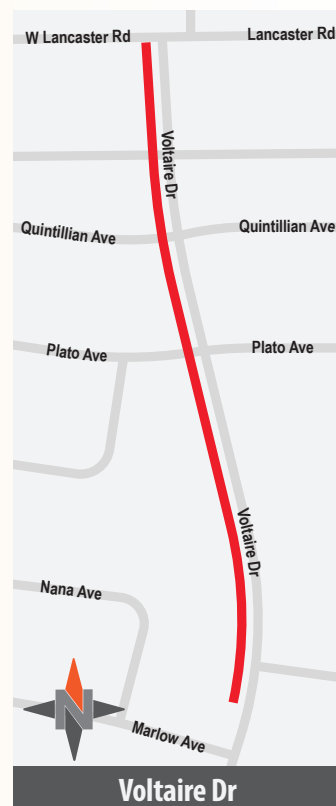
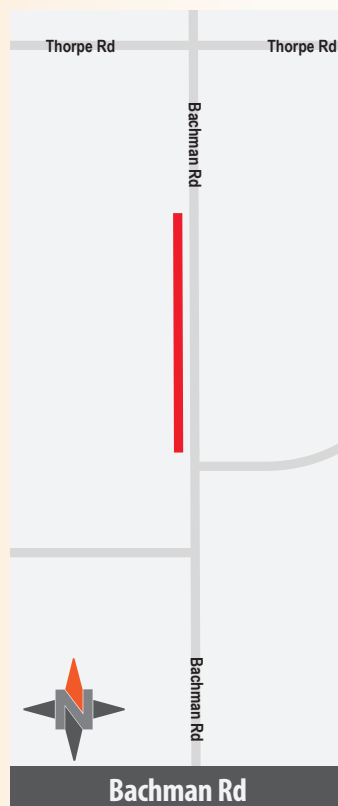
Starting at Legacy Oaks Drive and Bachman Road, the work will be completed in two locations at a time using trench excavation, pipe installation backfill, and a compaction process. Construction will be within the Orange County right-of-way and utility easements. Once the work is completed and tested, the areas will be restored, including irrigation that is removed or damaged.

Please expect temporary, single-lane closures and a detour on eastbound and westbound Whisper Lakes Boulevard. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to alert the traveling public to roadway changes. On Voltaire Drive, South Texas Avenue, Boice Street and Hawkes Avenue, expect temporary, single-lane closures with flagging operations to direct traffic.

Access to residences and emergency services will be maintained. Groundwater odor, noise and some vibration can be expected. Construction activities will take place between 7 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. The schedule may change due to unforeseen circumstances.

For safety reasons, please do not walk in the areas under construction. Motorists must follow the construction zone detours.
